Big Sister – An experienced quilter is often the best resource for a new quilter. Have a question? Ask a member. Need advice? Ask a Big Sister.

Hospitality – Set up and clean up of beverages and monthly member-supplied refreshments.

- **Cuddle Quilts** – Making and donating quilts for children with long-term disabilities in local hospitals and rehabilitation centers.
- **Friendship Quilts** - Making and donating quilts for residents in hospice and local nursing homes. Quilt sizes are on the VSQ website.

Special Events / Trip Coordination – If you want a group to go with you on your next outing, this is the perfect way to make new friends. Ideas and suggestions are always welcome.

Timeless Treasures Sale – The June luncheon provides the perfect opportunity to exchange quilting items with some profit going to the guild.

Website – Maintains and keeps current the VSQ website.

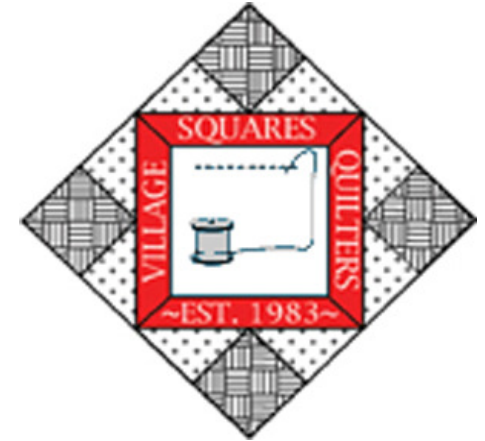
Organization
