ABOUT LENI LEVENSON WIENER:

Leni Levenson Wiener is an art quilter and instructor living in New Rochelle, NY. She has authored four books—*Thread Painting (2007), Photo-inspired Art Quilts (2009), 3 Fabric Quilts (2011)* and *Pictorial Art Quilt Guidebook (2014)* and her work appears in compilation books of art quilts—including *Art Quilt Portfolio: People and Portraits; The Best of Quilting Arts Magazine; 1000 Quilt Inspirations* and numerous magazine articles. In addition, she has self-published a full catalog of her traveling exhibition, "Park Bench Stories."

Her work, which is representational raw edge machine applique focusing on the body language of people caught in ordinary moments of their everyday lives, has been exhibited throughout the US and internationally. Her solo museum exhibition "Park Bench Stories" opened in 2015 at the Grants Pass Museum of Art in Oregon and traveled to galleries and museums throughout the US and selected pieces toured Europe. The run ended in the fall of 2021 at the National Quilt Museum in Paducah.

She has appeared on Quilting Arts and The Quilt Show several times.

Leni regularly teaches her techniques in workshops and also has an online class with **iquilt**. In addition, she coaches emerging artists to help them find their unique artistic voice and lectures on the topic.

Leni is proud to be a BERNINA Ambassador.

ABOUT HER LECTURE: Finding Your (Quilting) Voice

Your voice is a unique and recognizable artistic style that is distinctly your own; the ultimate form of self-expression that reflects your personality and vision in a way that no other artist could. This is true whether you are a traditional quilter, an art quilter, or anything else. Many artists grapple with finding their voice, what most don't realize is that their voice is there from the beginning, they just need to hear it and follow it. Leni will talk about the steps to take in order to find your voice. She will also share some new work since the last time she was here.
