SCRAPPY BLOCKS OF THE MONTH

Coordinated by Susan Wolman with Janice Ewing:

Hard to believe – but – we are coming to the end of this project. We started this adventure October 2022 and, if you are participating, please bring your completed (almost completed) top / quilt to the **October 2023 meeting for a group Show'n'Tell**. Remember, this was designed to be fun, so relax and enjoy it....maybe this could be your summer 2023 project as it not too late to join in the fun! Thanks for participating.

As a reminder, see below for a full listing of "colors by month" and the general instructions for this endeavor.

Each month we are suggesting 2 blocks, each block with a single color. Of course, you may add any colors that help beautify the block, but the goal is to highlight that month's individual colors.

Our plan is to have each participant complete her own multicolored guilt, either to keep or donate. (If it's for donation, VSQ will provide the batting, and if we have an appropriate color, a backing for the guilt.)



Month 1 (Nov)	Teal / Aqua	Gold
Month 2 (Dec)	Orange	Lime green
Month 3 (Jan)	Sky blue	Magenta/fuchsia
Month 4 (Feb)	Purple	Brown
Month 5 (Mar)	Grey	Maroon
Month 6 (Apr)	Pink	Tomato red
Month 7 (May)	Forest green	Lavender
Month 8 (June)	Yellow	Deep/dark red
Month 9 (July)	Navy	Salmon
Month 10 (August)	Your choice	Your choice

This listing provides a quilt of 20 blocks, as was done by our presenter at the September 2022 meeting. (See pic above)

Of course, the number of blocks you make is up to you. The size of the blocks is also personal choice. We suggest anywhere from 6 to 12 inches.

The lack of specificity is deliberate. Very relaxing requirements - just a sampler of color. Quick and easy to do. So have fun.

CANCELLEDJune 21 – 24, 2023 Vermont Quilt Festival - Essex Junction, VT. After the May edition of this newsletter went to Press, the Vermont Quilt Festival was cancelled. Here is an update from VQF regarding the subsequent cancellation of the virtual Kaffe Fassett event:

May 24, 2023 Announcement: "It is with heavy hearts that we must share some more difficult news. After much deliberation, the board of the Vermont Quilt Festival (VQF) has made the tough decision to cancel our much-anticipated virtual Kaffe Fassett event and, sadly, close down the Vermont Quilt Festival altogether. This was not a decision that we took lightly. We explored every possible avenue to continue the festival and provide the quilting community with the experiences and joy it has brought for over 45 years. However, due to various circumstances, the board came to the realization that it is no longer feasible for us to continue. We understand that many of you purchased tickets for the Kaffe Fassett event, and we want to assure you that refunds will be issued promptly."
